I am delighted to welcome everyone back to Primet Primary School for the new school year. It is a great school where we have your child at its heart and we want to do the best for your child every day.

We are very excited to get all the children back into school. The school has made all the necessary adjustments for COVID 19. All the information can be found on the website under the heading 'School in September 2020'. All year groups will remain in class bubbles during the day including playtimes and lunchtimes. Breakfast Club is available only by booking in advance and children will attend the club in their class bubbles. There will be no after school clubs for the time being as it is not possible to maintain the class bubbles across the range of clubs at this time.

Term starts on Wednesday 2nd September. All Year 1 to Year 6 children are expected to attend from Wednesday 2nd September in school uniform.
