## **Attendance & Punctuality**

Following a great start to the term, please could we ask that pupils arrive for school at 8:35am so that registers can be taken at 8:45am. This allows pupils to start the day with morning Maths, establishes routines and optimises learning time. Children arriving after 8:45am receive a late mark which will be recorded on their attendance record. If a pupil is going to be absent, please notify the School Office by 8.35am on T: 01282 864607.

## Resource packs for self-isolating children

Children unable to attend school because they are self-isolating will have a resource pack emailed to them. This pack will include work the children in school are completing in order to ensure self-isolating children don't miss out on schoolwork.



## Pupil data

Please ensure that you update school promptly with changes to home address, telephone numbers, emergency contact numbers, or medical information.

Please ensure that details of anyone authorised to collect you child from school have been given to school to prevent delays at home time.

### Bringing items into school

Due to Covid-19, please do not send items from home in with your child. This includes birthday cakes and treats for the children. If your child requires an item in school, please contact school before sending it in.

### Medical appointments

Please arrange medical appointments outside school times. If an appointment has to be arranged in school time, your child must still attend school before and/or after the appointment. Please notify school in advance if your child has an appointment.

#### Holidays taken in term time

Holidays in term time will **not** be authorised by school. In exceptional circumstances, leave from school may be authorised. If your child is going to be absent from school for any reason other than illness or a medical appointment, please complete an Absence Request Form and return it to school as soon as possible and before the first day of absence.
