Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find enclosed your child's Autumn 2020 Interim Report. As a school we feel that it is important that our parents and carers are updated termly as the children complete termly assessment points. This interim report is to keep you informed and so that you can see the progress your child is making in school. You will also receive an interim report in the Spring term and a full report in the Summer term.

The report provides a record of each individual pupil's attainments and achievements. The report contains an attainment grade for reading, writing, grammar and maths. That grade is based upon a test. Please see the guidance overleaf about the grading system. The full report also gives a summary of progress for each subject or area taught. In each report the children should receive a target on how they can improve and a grade for their effort made in each subject.

For attainment at this time of the school year, the children should be at the point of 'Just below' or 'Well below' the end of year target. The children are aiming to achieve the level of 'Expected' by May or June 2021. This gives the children two terms learning to further improve their test scores. We do not anticipate that children would be achieving 'Expected' at this stage in the school year. If your child is already at 'Expected' then they should be at 'Greater Depth' by the Summer.

The most effective use parents can make of this report is to sit down with their child and go through it carefully together. This document belongs to you.

The report provides an opportunity for your child to realise his/her own strengths and weaknesses and to set targets for the future. Please read it in full with your child, and then outline any comments you feel are appropriate on the comment slip enclosed. Please return the comment slip to your child's form teacher as soon as you are able.

Your child's attendance and punctuality are also noted on the report. The attendance is recorded up to Friday 11th December 2020. Any absences which are Covid related are not counted in the absence figures. School has an expectation that every child will be at school for more than 96% once school began in September.
