Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a great two weeks in school and I would like to thank all our Year 2 parents for their efforts with the remote learning since Monday. Year 2 will continue with remote learning next week and then will return to school on Monday 7th December. Bubble closures in school will happen from time to time and school have prepared for this. All the class work will be added to the school website with the teacher providing videos to explain what the children need to do. In addition, printouts of the work will be delivered to the children's homes. Please take a photograph of the work completed by the children and email it to the class teacher. We understand the difficulties this can cause so please do not hesitate to contact us if you need any support.

We continually review our response to the COVID pandemic working to keep all the children in school as much as possible. It is very important that you inform school if any family members or anyone in your household have any symptoms of Covid, or if anybody is going for a TEST. This information is vital so we can minimise the impact on the children's education. We can only do this with your continued support.

Assessment week has gone well and the children have shown how much progress they have made. Please be aware that the children's attainment after this Autumn's term in school should be at the level of well below or just below their expected level for the end of this year. If your child is on this level or better they are on track for the year and should reach the expected level by June 2021. This does not take into account the time missed at school due to the pandemic which will also have some bearing on the children's outcomes.

Last of all, the children around school are doing some amazing work and it is a privilege to see some of the children making outstanding progress. The children in Reception are doing some wonderful writing now and this is amazing considering it is so early in the year.

Keep up your great efforts and have a lovely weekend.


