Eid Celebration Day - Henna Consent Form

As part of our our Eid Celebration Day on Monday 17th May, Y6 children will have the opportunity to use henna to draw Mehndi patterns on their hands. Henna is a natural dye made from a plant, mixed with water, tea, coffee, or lemon juice, and applied to the skin. It will remain on the skin for a few days, but is not permanent. It will, however, permanently stain clothing if it comes into contact with it before drying. Black henna will not be used. *Please be aware that an allergic reaction is possible, but uncommon.*

If you prefer your child not to have a henna pattern on their hand, they will have the opportunity to draw a henna pattern on paper instead.
