Dear parents and carers,

I would like to welcome everyone back for the last half term of school. Unfortunately, yesterday we had to close a bubble due to a case of COVID 19. The children in this bubble will be able to access remote learning from Monday. This is an unfortunate event and this may continue to happen from time to time. As a school we are still managing this pandemic as we have always done with all classes working in bubbles so we keep the year groups separated. We expect this to continue for some time and will maintain all measures necessary until we are advised otherwise. I would like to thank all the families, children and staff for following these measures in and around school so we can keep everyone safe.

Next week is assessment week for all the children. The staff are excited to see how well the children will do. For your child to do well it is important that they arrive to school in plenty of time (doors to school open at 8.35am) and not to miss any days next week. Children who are at school every day and are on time make the best progress. The class who are self-isolating will complete their tests when they return to school.

I would like to welcome two new members of staff who have started with us this week. Miss Novak is now working in EYFS supporting Miss Gleave. She joins the school with lots of experience and she is excited to be here and to make a difference for your children at Primet Primary. Mrs Greenwood is joining the Welfare Team and she also comes with lots of experience in schools. She is excited to be part of our great lunchtime team, helping and caring for the children during their lunchtime break. On Monday next week there will be another advert for a Welfare position so if you are interested in joining the staff at Primet Primary please enquire at the office.

Primet Primary will soon be providing after school child care for our pupils. This will be organised in a similar way to breakfast club and will be available from 3.10pm to 5.10pm starting on Monday 6th September 2021. There will be a cost, to be confirmed, but this addition to our provision at school will enable us to provide more support to our whole school community. Letters for this will go out before the end of term to see which days you may require childcare.

As you may be aware, one of our school families has suffered a bereavement this week.
