Transition in school and new classes 2021/2022

We were going to hold transition day in school this Thursday. However due to the rise in cases in the community we feel it wouldn't be sensible to go ahead with moving class bubbles to join their new teaching staff. This has the potential to lead to class closures. As a school we have been able to manage restrictions in school and for the large part have been able to keep school open. It has been our constant aim to keep school open as much as possible so that children can attend. Transition will be completed with staff meeting your children at some point this term. Children with additional needs will have additional opportunities to visit their new class and meet staff to make the process as smooth as possible.

Children new into EYFS for September will now not attend school on Thursday 1st July 2021. The children will now complete their transition day on Friday 3rd September. They will have a morning or afternoon session as previously organised on that day. The children will be able to attend transition day in their new school uniform.

I am pleased to inform you of the staffing structure for the next academic year (2021/2022). Our staffing remains very similar to last year. The only changes are that Miss Dawson will teach Year 5 in the afternoons and will remain in Year 2 on Fridays. Miss Richards will teach Year 2 Mondays to Thursdays.

We welcome Miss Jaggars who has joined Year 3 as a teaching Assistant. She will move to Y4 in September.
