


Here is a picture of a lighthouse structure made by Miss O'Keefe.


Over the next few slides, you will see the different steps to construct a lighthouse.



## Collect the equipment and materials that you will need.



First, use a glue stick to add glue to the cardboard tube. Wrap the white paper tightly around the tube. Tuck any loose paper into the ends of the tube and secure the paper with sellotape or glue.



Next cut three even strips of red card. Try keep these the same size and width. Wrap these around your lighthouse and cut off any excess card.



Using a piece of card, cut a circle slightly bigger than your yogurt pot. This will be used as the part of the gallery deck and to secure the lantern.

You could add yellow tissue paper inside the yogurt pot to represent the light before you stick the yogurt pot to the card. Attach the yogurt pot to the tube. Sellotape would be best.
