



My Must do Weekly Tasks

Read my reading book every night.
Practise Phonics spelling lists every week.

The expectation is to complete at least 1 of the activities from the menu below BUT if you really want to impress ... do more!

You can complete the tasks in any order and can hand them in as you finish them.

Before starting each task, you must write the type of task and date in your Home Learning exercise book.

Present:

Can you find out some facts about elephants to share with the class? You could find out where they live, what they eat or what baby elephants are called. Have a look in non-fiction books or use the internet to help you.

Design:

Elmer the elephant is unique and special with his patchwork skin. Design your own elephant using all your favourite colours and patterns.

Create:

Using your design, make your own elephant. Perhaps you could make a junk model elephant using boxes and tubes or fabric to make an elephant puppet.

Social:

Some elephants live in the jungle with lots of other animals. Can you think of any other animals that live in the jungle? Try making some noises like different jungle animals, for your friends and family to guess! You could growl like a tiger, chatter like a monkey, roar like a lion or snap like a crocodile! Try doing some actions too!

Service:

We are learning about our families and the roles/responsibilities that different family members have. Can you help your family by doing jobs around the house? You could do some tidying, dusting, hoovering etc.

Write:

We are learning about lots of different types of families. Can you draw and label your family? Write some sentences about your family and why they are special to you.
