FOR PARENTS OF Y3 CHILDREN - CLOSE CONTACTS OF COVID 19 at Primet Primary School

Dear Parent or Carer,

We have been made aware that we have a possible positive case of coronavirus (COVID-19) at Primet Primary School in our Y3 class.

We have followed the national guidance and have identified that your child in Year 3 has been in close contact with the possible case. In line with national guidelines your child must complete a lateral flow test every morning for the next 7 days. These measures are to protect everyone in the local community. Please text school or email [sbm@primet.lancs.sch.uk](mailto:sbm@primet.lancs.sch.uk) if your child tests positive on any of the lateral flow tests as soon as possible.

At this stage we would like to stress that we are awaiting confirmation of a positive PCR test, but believe that the safest and most appropriate course of action is to notify you now that your child may have been a contact of a case of Covid 19 and to remind you of the guidance in force at this time.

Your child can continue their normal activities unless their lateral flow test is positive. If their lateral flow test is positive you must notify school and must arrange for your child to take a PCR test. Your child must then self isolate until you receive their test result. If the result is positive they will need to continue to self isolate and anyone else who has been a close contact of them will need to take LFT tests every day. If the PCR result is negative your child can return to normal activities and everyone else in the household can continue as usual.

Due to current problems in the supply chain, we are aware of a shortage of Lateral Flow Tests in the local community. We are therefore sending your child home with a box containing 7 lateral flow tests.

Can I thank all our parents for your continued support. We are always available to speak to at school and we are happy to discuss any concerns you may have.
