I must start by saying thank you to all our families, children, parents and staff who are working through the current wave of Covid in school. Thanks to everyone for testing and identifying children who have symptoms; this has meant school has been able to remain fully open with the children continuing to learn. Without these efforts the situation at school would be much worse. If you are unsure of what to do with any cases in your family please ring school and we can give you the latest advice.

Because we have been in socially distanced class bubbles since the start of term, we have been unable to start after school clubs. However from next week we will be starting some clubs for single classes. As soon as we come out of bubbles, additional classes will be added. After school childcare and breakfast club remain open as the children sit in their own bubbles. Catch up groups have also started and the children are enjoying the small group tuition.

We have had lots of new children start this term and they have all settled into school life well here at Primet. The children and staff have made them feel most welcome. This has meant that nearly all the year groups are full and we are nearly at capacity.
