As you are aware your children are completing their end of year tests beginning on Monday 9th May. The children will be completing the following exams:

Grammar with spelling (Monday 9th May)
Reading (Tuesday 10th May)
Maths Arithmetic and Maths Reasoning (Wednesday 11th May and Thursday 12th May)

There is some information below which will help the children to be prepared for the week. We are inviting our parents to a meeting to explain the week in greater detail. The meeting will take place on Wednesday 27th April at 2.30pm and will finish in time for you to collect your children from school at the normal time.

It is very important that the children complete all the tests. Therefore the children must not be late or absent during SATS week as your children perform best if they complete the test at the correct time and are not worried about being late. The children can attend the breakfast club from 7.15 am if they wish, free of charge for that week. We will be serving breakfast free of charge to all Year 6 children at 8.30am on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday that week.
