If you must have fireworks at home, please follow this safety advice.

DOs 🗹

- Only buy fireworks from retailers registered with MFRS
- Keep fireworks in a closed box
- Follow the instructions on each firework
- Light them at arm's length, using a taper
- Stand well back
- Always supervise children around
- fireworks • Light sparklers one at a time and
- wear gloves

DON'Ts 🔀

- Don't drink alcohol if setting off fireworks
- Never go near a firework that has been lit. Even if it hasn't gone off, <u>it could</u> still explode
- Never put fireworks in your

- Never give sparklers to a child under five
- Don't let fireworks off after 11pm
