Thank you for your continued support and we are always free to speak with every day at school.

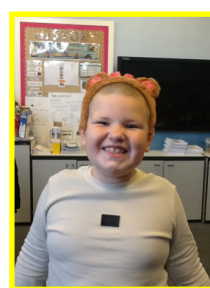
