As you are aware your children are completing their end of year tests beginning on Monday 13th May. The children will be completing the following exams:

- Grammar with spelling (Monday 13th May)
- Reading (Tuesday 14th May)
- Maths Arithmetic and Maths Reasoning (Wednesday 15th May and Thursday 16th May)

There is some information below which will help the children to be prepared for the week.

It is very important that the children complete all the tests. Therefore the children must not be late or absent during SATS week as your children perform best if they complete the test at the correct time and are not worried about being late. The children can attend the breakfast club from 7.15 am if they wish, free of charge for that week.
