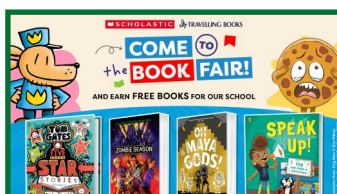

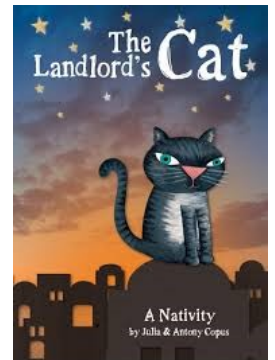
KS1 Christmas Performance
