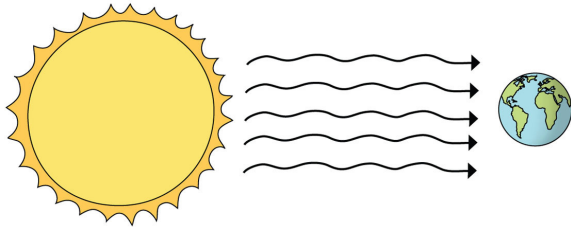


The Sun and the Stars

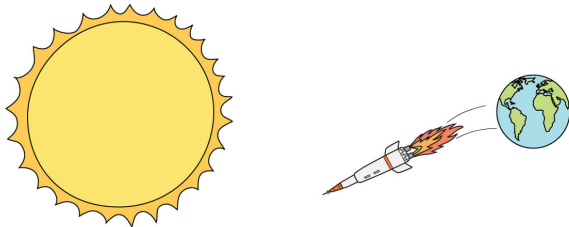
We are on a planet called Earth.

We get light from the Sun and it keeps planet Earth hot.

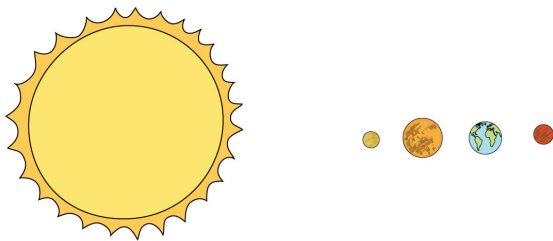


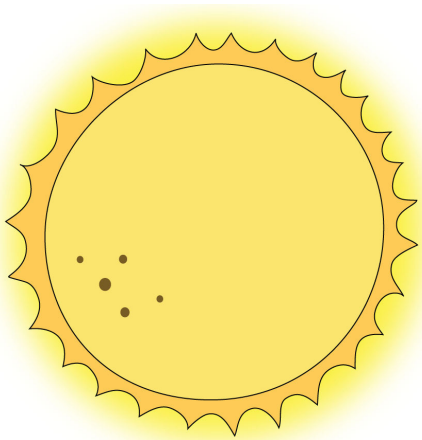
We cannot go to the Sun. It is too far away and it is much too hot.

The planets Mercury and Venus are between Earth and the Sun. The planets are too hot for us to get to.



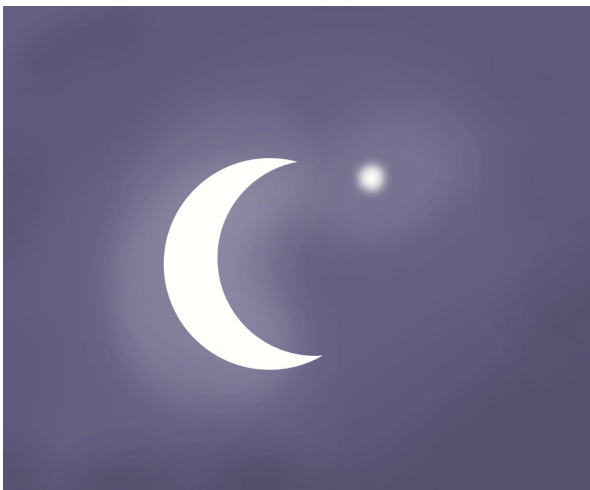


The Sun is a star. It is the nearest star to planet Earth.
